The Constitution (Amendment) Act, 1979

Short title.

[14th June, 1979]

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament
in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation
on the 14th day of June, 1978.

Commence-
ment.

Repeal and
Replace-
ment of
Section 158
of Act No.12
of 1978.

2. Section 158 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone,
1978 is hereby repealed and replaced by the following
new section-

"Consequen-
tial Provi-
sions.

158. The provisions of any Consequential
Provisions Act made under this Constitution
and of any Act relating to Citizenship
shall not be amended, repealed, re-enacted
or replaced unless the Bill incorporating
such amendment, repeal, re-enactment or
replacement is supported at the final vote
thereupon by the votes of not less than
two-thirds of the Members of Parliament."

one thousand nine hundred and seventy-nine.
